Please label everything with your child's name or initials. This includes your child's uniforms! It is especially helpful if you label each crayon, marker, pencil and dry erase marker individually.

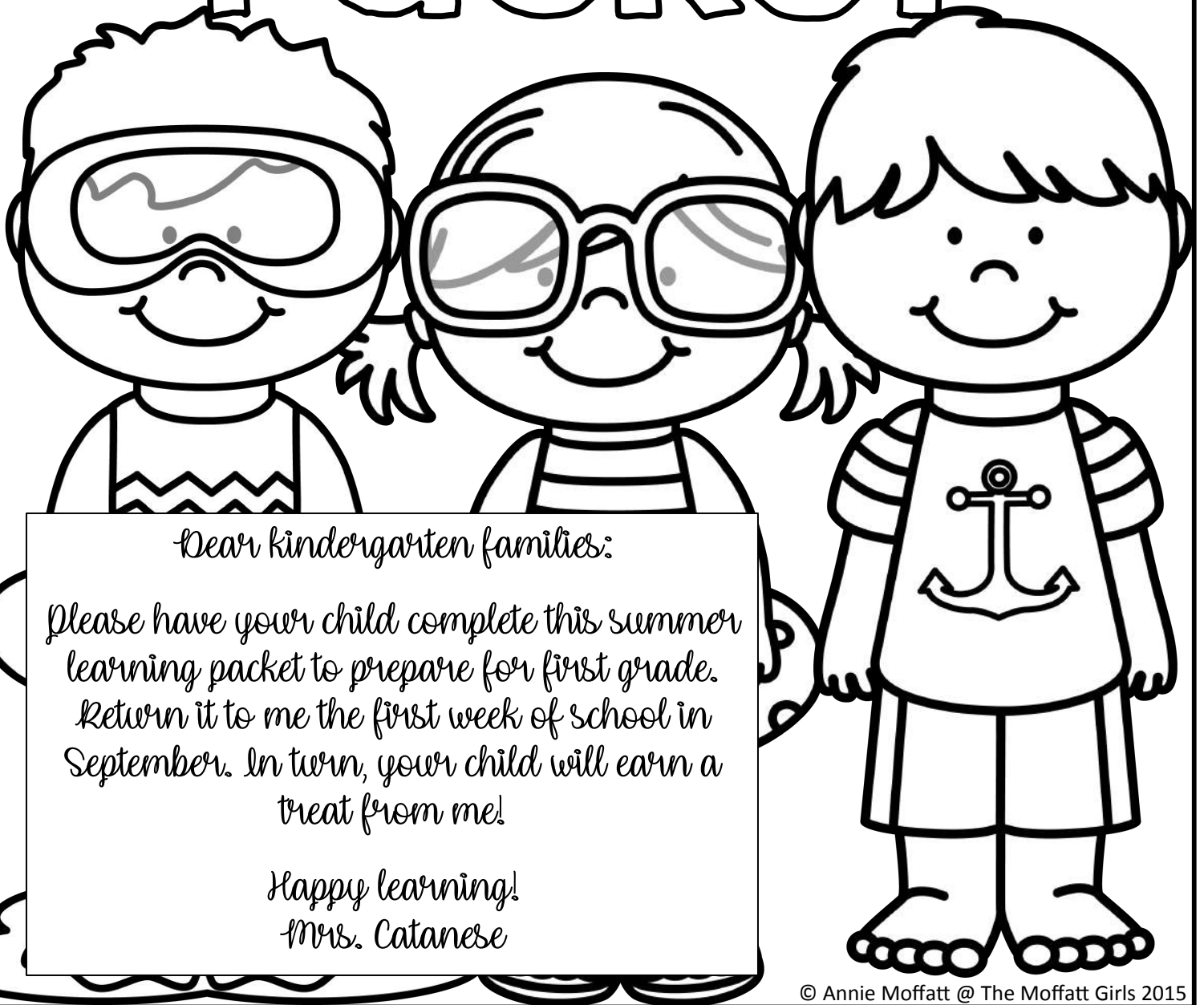
Your child may need a replenishment of school supplies during his or her time in first grade. You will be notified of this as necessary.

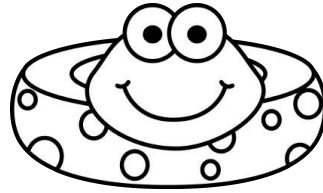


Dear kindergarten families:
