Divided into subgroups: Pastors & Business Managers, and Pastors & Administrator and Administrators & Trustees Working within Vicariates. Bishops plan to work though Vicars to have parishes and schools work together to save costs making them financially solvent. If parishes are not proactive, we believe they will be directed by the diocese. We are being proactive. Vicars will have big say in who is in what group. Geography, cultures, demographics etc. Don't know when Bishop will proceed. As a group we need to come up with cost saving plan. Further discussion will happen: The stronger and more proactive we are gives us greater standing.
