



Mrs. Greaves' Kindergarten School Supply List - Fall 2024

Please label the following:

- 1 backpack (no wheels)
- 1 water bottle. Please label with your child's name.
- 1 plastic pencil box to be kept in desk. Please make sure it is sturdy and closes easily
- 1 (4 pack) of ultra-fine tip dry erase markers.. any color!
- Magnetic dry erase board
- 3 boxes of Crayola Classic Crayons (24 count)
- 1 package of washable Crayola markers (Please label each)
- 12 pack Elmer's Regular Glue Sticks. Please label each one.
- 6 Elmer's JUMBO Glue Sticks
- Children's Fiskars scissors (or any other good brand...cheap ones do not cut well) - Please test out the scissors on a piece of paper to make sure an adult can easily cut
- One inch 3 ring binder with clear protective plastic covering (so papers can be inserted in the front cover). Pockets on the side are a plus!
- 1 pack large Ticonderoga pencils
- Handheld pencil sharpener
- 1 box of 25 clear 3 ring binder sheet protectors (please put in 3 ring binder)
- **Clear** zipper pencil pouch for 3 ring binder (all money/school orders should be sent to school in this)
- 1 Extra set of **non- uniform clothes** (including socks and underwear) to be kept in school. Please label all items and put in a zip-locked labeled bag.
- Index cards - 3 by 5
- Clipboard - full sized

- 1 Art smock

- 1 black and white composition notebook



No need to label these...

- **2 rolls of paper towels**
- **3 boxes of tissues**
- **4 containers of Clorox wipes**
- **160 count packages of baby wipes (any brand) ...very necessary for sticky hands!**
- **1 bottle of hand sanitizer**
- **1 package of large Ziplock bags**
- **1 ream of copy paper**
- **1 Family picture to put on our bulletin board for the Class Fridge! :)**
