

Can My Child Attend School Today?

Answer the 4 questions in the blue boxes

Did your child come into close contact (within 6 ft.) with someone who has a laboratory confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis in the past 14 days?

- Note by a health care provider is preferred upon return to school after quarantine of 14 days

Does your child have symptoms of respiratory illness such as a cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell, significant diarrhea or sore throat?

Does your child have a fever (greater than 100 F or 37.8 C)?

Did your child travel to a state or country with a positive test rate higher than 10 per 100,000 residents, or higher than a 10% test positivity rate, over a 7-day rolling average?

- Contact the Dept. of Health
- Self-Quarantine for 14 days

- Attend school
- If your child has not been absent for illness they may go directly to class

Has your child been fever free without medication for 72 hours?

Were they seen by their doctor and diagnosed with something other than COVID-19?

If your child has a fever or other symptoms that could be from COVID-19 and does not get tested OR is not cleared by your doctor, it is assumed the child has COVID-19 and may not return to school until the following criteria are met:

- At least 72 hrs. have passed since recovery. (no fever without the use of medication), **AND**
- child has improvement of symptoms, **AND** at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared

If no contact with anyone who tested positive for COVID-19, student may return to school with a doctors note, **OR**,
- 2 separate confirmations at least 24 hours apart that they are free of COVID-19 per infection tests at an approved testing location.
- However, if your child was in contact with someone who tested positive, see the criteria in the yellow box.
